



- g. The Returning Officer will count the votes for the candidates for Chancellor and the candidate with the highest score will be declared Chancellor. Where there is an even score a secret ballot will be held at the December Council Meeting.
- h. The process in (g) will then be repeated for Pro-Chancellor, if required.
- i. The Office of Chancellor and Pro-Chancellor will, subject to the provision of the Education and Training Act, be held for one year usually commencing December each year.
- j. If a vacancy arises in the Office of Chancellor and/or Pro-Chancellor before December in any year then the Council shall by resolution, as soon as practicable thereafter, instruct the Returning Officer to commence the election for the successor in terms of this Statute. The person(s) so elected shall hold office for
